#### 1) Overview of REPAC and Board/Committee Introductions:

- 3) Review and Approval of the Budget (Linda Walters (treasurer) couldn't make it. Chris Lee, VP presented):
  - Have a surplus not many expenses due to the pandemic. Decided to set aside a \$10K future buffer fund. Can be adjusted via amendments later if changes need to be made.
  - Carry-over of \$15K. Budget is around \$32K. Expenses \$25K, would give a surplus of about \$7K
  - Biggest source of revenue is the Durham Bulls Concessions. Additional money comes from spirit wear & Science Olympiad concessions.

Line Item explanations:

- Covid pandemic support- can be used as needed
- New this year SAGE (Student Advancement Grant for Engineering) grants to support students for engineering projects
- Clubs \$410 for a full group membership to the Technology Student Association
- The Durham Bulls baseball season and fiscal year don't line up total Bulls money raised this summer was about \$12K. Money still coming. With cashless sales, the device required tip or no tip. Revenue went way up in comparison with previous years.
- The equipment line item is for the maker space, etc. CTE central office has been supportive, but some things don't fall under what's covered (furniture, storage units)
- Motion to approve the budget from Chris Lee, Second Henry Sommerville: no dissenters. **Budget** approved as written.
